That is about all for now. Have a safe and wonderful break. We look forward to an exciting term 3.

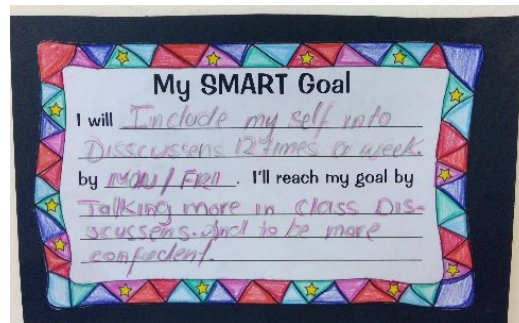
