NAPLAN Results

All students in years 3, 5 and 7 that sat the NAPLAN testing received their results on Monday. These should have arrived home in a sealed envelope. If you have not received the results, please talk to your child. If they did not receive them, please contact the school and we will copy the results and send them home via Australia post.

Overall our schools results were positive. We have had a number of students with very high scores and some students that are still working on the skills and learning required to complete the testing successfully. All our staff will be analysing the results and aligning them with programs for 2022. If your child is heading to high school in 2022, these results will follow your child to their high school.

High School Enrolment Documentation

We have a large number of students heading to high school in 2022, 64 in fact. Each of these students have been through a placement process and are now expected to have all enrolment documentation completed and sent back to their high school. If you have not completed these documents, please attend to this as soon as possible. If you have not received the enrolment documents or lost them, please contact the high school as soon as possible as high school spots are limited and no enrolment papers may cause your child to miss out.

Sports day tomorrow

As you are aware sports day is tomorrow. This is a chance for our students to demonstrate their skills in a number of different areas including high jump, bean bag toss, dress-up relay, target ball and of course the sprints. Team work will be a major focus for the day and extra points will be allocated as students demonstrate positive team work and care for their fellow competitors.

SCHOOL HOLIDAY TREATS



CHOCOLATE CRACKLES

250gm (1 Block) Copha 4 cups Rice Bubbles
125gm (1 cup) icing sugar 60gm (1/2 cup) Cocoa powder
100gm (1 cup) desiccated coconut

METHOD

Line a standard 12 cup muffin tray with paper cases.

Melt Copha in microwave on high or in a saucepan until fully melted. Mix Rice bubbles, icing sugar, cocoa powder and desiccated coconut in a large bowl. Add in the melted Copha and stir to combine.

Spoon crackle mix evenly into the prepared muffin cups.

Place in fridge for 1 hour to set.

FRUIT SMOOTHIE

1 cup vanilla yoghurt ¼ cup orange juice
1 cup frozen strawberries 1 frozen banana

METHOD

Puree all ingredients in a blender until smooth.

Place in fridge to chill
